EVENT SUMMARY

8th CEREBROVASCULAR GRAND ROUND Webinar, 17 August 2021

The 8th chapter of the great Cerebrovascular Grand Round Webinar, held under the auspices of the **MENA STROKE Organization**, **American Stroke Association**, and **World Stroke Organization**, and supported by Boehringer Ingelheim and Medtronic, was a unique session to provide comprehensive education about microbleed and acute IS management, and endovascular cases. It revealed the updates in diagnosis and treatments of the condition. The webinar has helped **770 delegates from 27** countries around the world.

Dr. Suhail Abdulla Alrukn, President of MENASO and Consultant Neurology at Rashid Hospital, UAE, has appointed Dr. Saif A AlZaabi, American and Canadian Board Certified Consultant Interventional Radiologist, Chief of Clinical Advanced **Programs** Integration, and Director of International Collaboration HealthConnect, Oman, and Dr. Adel Alhazzani, Vice President of MENASO and Associate Professor Of Neurology at College of Medicine, King Saud University, KSA, as Chairmen for the webinar. The panel of speakers includes Prof. Pooja Khatri, Professor Neurology Rehabilitation and Medicine at University of Cincinnati, Ohio, USA, and Dr. Riyadh AL-Okaili, Neuro-Interventional Endovascular-Surgeon and Neuro-Radiologist King at Faisal Specialist Hospital and Research Center, Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.

Webinar Chairman Dr. Saif A AlZaabi has delivered the opening remarks and Dr. Adel Alhazzani introduced Prof. Pooja Khatri to deliver her lecture on Microbleed and Acute IS Management.

Prof. Dr. Pooja Khatri's lecture has begun with mentioning the importance of initial imaging and she said that all patients with suspected should acute stroke receive emergency brain imaging evaluation on first arrival to a hospital before initiating any specific therapy to treat AIS. She differentiated hemorrahagic Infarction, primary intracerebral hemorrahage, subarachnoid hemorrahage, subdural and hemorrahage. Prof. Pooja recommended the administration of IV alteplase in eligible patients without first obtaining MRI to exclude cerebral microbleeds (CMBs).

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During the conclusion, she suggested that significant microbleed is uncommon and if signidican MB status is unknown, weigh the risks/benefits. For EVT, would typically treat patient regardless of any known microbleed burden. Obtaining an MRI mat be warranted in elderly patients with dementia, small vessel disease, or spontaneous ICH, for whom risks may outweigh benefits.

Webinar Chairman Dr. Saif A AlZaabi Adel Alhazzani and Dr. have conducted the Q&A session. The interactive session was fruitful with many questions from the attendees. Chairmen express their sincere and appreciated aratitude the attendees for their participation.

Webinar Chairman **Dr. Saif A AlZaabi** has introduced **Dr. Riyadh AL-Okaili** to deliver her lecture on **Endovascular Cases in 2020**.

Dr. Riyadh AL-Okaili's lecture was centered on NeuroIntervention that focused on two different approaches such as Tour of NIR vs Poster Child, and Cases vs Technical vs blend. The NIR vs Poster Child approach consists of diagnostic role, aneurysm, AVM, oncology, vascular spine. and approach anomalies. The later includes devices, cases, technique. His lecture has broadly discussed the healthcare, stroke care, and stroke intervention. Dr. Rivadh explained Angio suite, recanalization or antegrade, and also discussed special cases on refractory stroke, pediatrics, and femoral access is closed.




